Introduction

The world has faced very difficult consequences due to the transmission of infectious novel corona virus which caused educational institutions to close their campuses and forced them to initiate online teaching. In these circumstances, the use of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) tools has been increased significantly. The educational institutions and the governments have taken many online initiatives based on ICTs for learners to continue their education. Most of the libraries specially, academic libraries have introduced bunches of innovative ideas into their libraries during the Covid-19 pandemic for their users.

A research study to identify the use of social media in floriculture and the process of online marketing has been carried out in the districts of Kalimpong and Darjeeling, West Bengal. Another research focuses on the present use of print media as well as information and communication technology infrastructure and the contemporary use of electronic information resources in college libraries under West Bengal State University. During Covid-19 Pandemic most of the educational institutions have shifted to online mode for teaching learning activities.
